Roland TSA Membership Meeting

All students interested in joining TSA must attend this meeting which occurs at the end of August or 1st of September.

Additional Roland TSA Fundraisers

All members must participate or donate. Amount of donation may vary from year to year.

Roland Technology Challenge:

*Level 1 (Top 10 students)

*Level 2 (Top 14 students)

4 points = 1st Place

2 points = 2nd Place

1 Points = 3rd Place

Ties may be broken through an interview process about the event

*The total number of RTSA Active Members (24) may be altered based on number of participants, number of males vs. females, local resources, upperclassmen, and other potential factors determines by the advisor.

TSA Membership:

2.0 GPA

Be enrolled in Technology Engineering (Tech-Ed)/ Tech-Connect or have previously been enrolled for one year.

Not all TSA members are *active* members

TSA *Active* Membership:

2.0 GPA (C average)

Members are responsible for purchasing Roland TSA Shirts and/or Official Dress (See official dress requirements). Some blazers are available on a first come basis

Be enrolled in Technology Engineering (Tech-Ed)/ Tech-Connect or have previously been enrolled for one year.

Qualify at the Roland Technology Challenge

Great American Fundraiser (sell the set minimum or donate \$75.00)

Participate in Additional RTSA Fundraisers (must meet minimum participation)

Attend membership and monthly TSA meetings

TSA Community Service Project:

Required by all TSA members

Usually around Thanksgiving or Christmas holidays

TSA Regional Contest Participants:

Open to active members only

Academically eligible

Official Dress is required

Be in good standing with the advisor and school

Behaviorally acceptable

Pay registration 2 weeks prior to contest or by registration date chosen by advisor

Be entered in at least 2 events and have them both finished one week prior to contest or by registration date chosen by advisor

TSA State Contest Participant:

Open to active members only

Academically eligible

Be in good standing with the advisor and school

Official Dress is required

Behaviorally acceptable

Be a TSA member throughout the whole school year (since Roland Technology Challenge)

Have placed top 3 in at least two different events during the current school year

Pay registration 2 weeks prior to contest or by registration date chosen by advisor

Be entered in at least 2 events and have them both finished one week prior to contest or by registration date chosen by advisor

Attended 2 regional contests

Met community service project

Pass the congressional degree test with an accuracy of 90%. The member will get one retake.

Completed application process

Advisor reserves the right select students for state based on a point system

*Advisor reserves the right to an open door policy, allowing students with subpar qualifications to attend the state contest.

TSA National Contest Participant:

Open to active members only

Academically eligible

Official Dress is required

Be in good standing with the advisor and school

Behaviorally acceptable

Be a TSA member throughout the whole school year (since Roland Technology Challenge)

Have placed top 3 in at least one qualifying event at the state contest

Pay registration 2 weeks prior to contest or by registration date chosen by advisor

Be entered in at least 2 events and have them both finished one week prior to contest or by registration date chosen by advisor

Attended 2 regional contests and the state contest

Met community service project

Pass the senatorial degree test with an accuracy of 90%. The member will get one retake.

Completed application process

Pay travel and national contest dues determined by the advisor

A legal guardian may be required to attend the conference at their own expense

RTSA will not attend the national conference every year, even if funds are available

No student may participate in the national contest without the approval of the advisor

Roland TSA Excellence Award (Awarded to active seniors only)

2 years of active involvement (since 9th grade)

3.3 cumulative GPA

2 community service projects (since 9th grade)

No grade lower than a B in Technology classes

Place top 10 in at least two events at state contest (since 9th grade)

Hold a chapter office for 1 year (since 9th grade)

2 letters of teacher recommendations (advisor recommendation will not be accepted)
